2006 HUNT REPORT

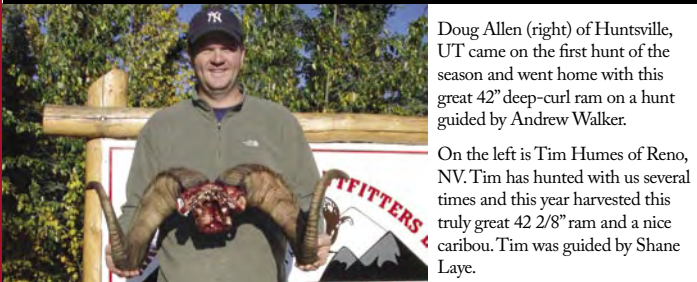

The 2006 hunting season was above-average in most respects. Our hunters went home with many great rams with the average at 38.5" and 10.3-years-old overall. Thirteen rams measured 39" or better with the longest at 42 2/8". We got ten rams that scored 160 B&C or better with the best scoring ram right at 170 B&C (green). It was also a very good year for Mountain caribou. Twelve of the harvested grossed 390 B&C or better. The mixed-bag moose hunters went home with moose in the 57" to 58" range, which is our long-term average.

The weather for most of the season was as good as it gets in the mountains. From our arrival in camp in early July until late August, we only had about 2 half days that weren't huntable. We had some foul weather in late August/early September which was not unexpected. Later September was very warm with little or no snow, even in the high country. There was no forest fire smoke at any time during the season which was the first time in a long time.

We have added another page to our Hunt Report this year - with most guides and hunters now carrying digital cameras, we get more photos sent to us than in the past and we want to put as many as possible into our report. The number of hunters that we take out remains the same every year.

As always, we had a great bunch of hunters again in 2006. Backpack hunting attracts a special breed of hunter who come north to hunt for all the right reasons - they enjoy all aspects of a backpack hunt, including the physical challenge, the great scenery, the camaraderie, and the knowledge that there is a reasonable chance to harvest an exceptionally trophy anywhere within our outfitting area. We get many repeat hunters each year - this year 50% of the hunters have hunted with us before. Our entire crew always works hard to make sure that you have a safe, enjoyable, and successful hunt with us - your satisfaction is our future success.

Jesus Gutierrez of Mexico returned for his fifth hunt with us and got this great, solid 12-year-old ram with guide Al Klassen.



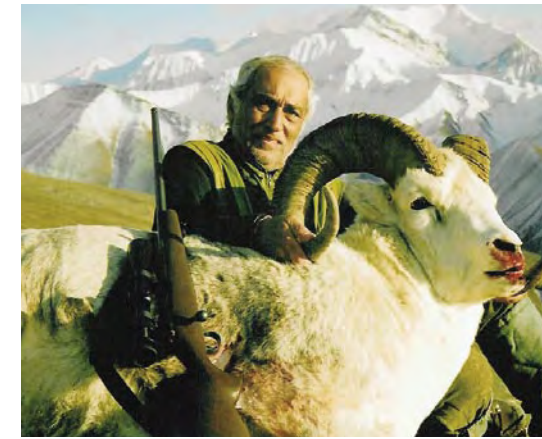
Travis Jensen of Salt Lake City, UT hunted with guide Jeremy Bergen and went home with this good-looking ram and a bow-killed caribou.

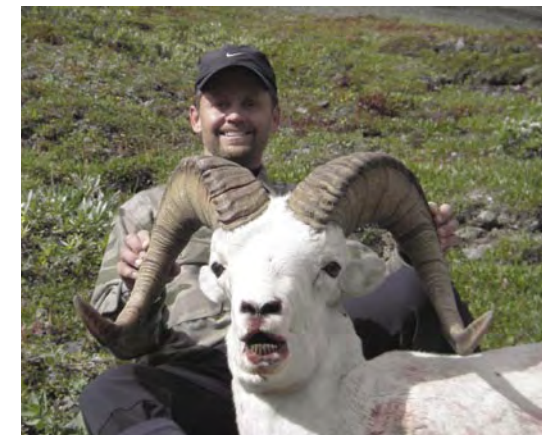

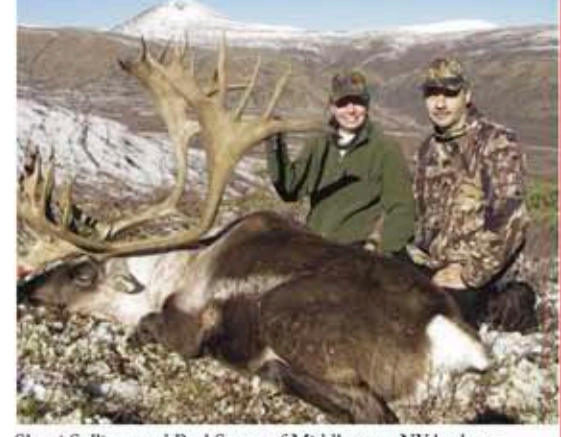
